Purpose of processing personal data	We process the respondents' data in the research project "ArenDt" for the scientific study of anti-Semitism in the public interest (legal basis). This also includes an online survey in which Jews living in Germany are asked about their perception of and dealings with anti-Semitism. Finally, the results of our research are integrated into programs for democracy promotion and extremism prevention by our practice partner <i>Netzwerk für Demokratie und Courage</i> .
Source of your data	The contact details of the respondents (name, address, email address, etc.) are not available to us researchers. We randomly selected communities from among the Jewish communities in Germany, which we then wrote to, asking them to establish contact with the respondents themselves. In this way, we want to ensure the highest possible level of confidentiality.
